

ST NINIANS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST LIMITED

The St Ninians Community Development Trust was established on 22nd November 2002 by the three local Community Councils of Borestone, Broomridge and Torbrex and the Cultenhove Opportunities Partnership. It was formed as a Company Limited by Guarantee with no share capital (Company Number SC240022). It is also registered as a Scottish Charity (Charity Number SC033912). Membership is open to anyone over the age of 17, living or working with the St Ninians area.

The Trust was set up to promote any charitable purpose for the benefit of the inhabitants of the St Ninians area of the City of Stirling. In particular the Trust aims to help improve the well being of those who live or work in the St Ninians area and work towards improving the local environment. The Trust seeks to achieve these aims by promoting and supporting co-operation between the local and statutory authorities and local voluntary organisations. In particular, the Trust works closely with the three local Community Councils, the Cultenhove Opportunities Partnership, the Local Area Forum and Stirling Council.

Using its charitable status and St Ninians wide remit, the Trust seeks to work in partnership with local groups and organisations to apply directly for funding and to support them in their fundraising activities. Since its inception, the Trust has directly obtained funding for a major community survey to identify local priorities for development; promoting activities for young people in the Mayfield Centre; the development of a community tubs project and the development of a community garden in Broomridge and set up a Freepost license to enable community survey work to be undertaken.

The Trust is currently working in partnership consisting of the Stirling High School Eco-Team, the Friends of Beechwood Park and Torbrex Community Council regarding funding for a poly tunnel, the creation of a community raised garden and the development of the school pond. It is hoped that a further partnership related to Stirling Council's Beechwood Park Masterplan process will lead to applications for funding to support future developments in the park.
