Cllr Farmer emphasised that there had been a serious lack of consultation with the public particularly as no mention has as yet been made about outpatient clinics. Moving outpatient services to Larbert would make access for the public even more difficult.

- 7. Beechwood Scouts update:** Murray Dickie reported on the very satisfactory progress being made with the improvements to the Beechwood Scouts H.Q.
